Discussion

a. Discussion regarding approving a policy for independent educational evaluations. (1st Reading) -- TM 1st, MN 2nd - CB stated that the version being considered for YRCS is identical to that proposed by the JPA (Joint Powers Agency) entered into by several charter schools to share support services. MN/RW proposed informing a family that is currently inquiring about such a policy of this draft as it may affect their near term plans. All to submit any comments prior to Fri. Feb 4 to prepare for final approval at the next meeting.

4. Action

a. Shall the council approve a contract for the purchase of property on Rough and Ready Hwy? -- TM 1st, DR 2nd - Negotiations by CB reduced the previous selling price to \$460,000. Passed unanimously. The contract calls for a 120 day escrow, with small good faith payments due to the seller at 30 day intervals.
