- 2 Role Call/Class Check In Class update/parent concerns

During class check-ins, Christina mentioned that some kindergarten parents have expressed concerns that there are kindergarteners wandering the hallways without a parent. It is supposed that it was from trips to the restroom, but there was discussion regarding whether there is a standard policy across kindergartens on children being supervised on restroom trips – appears there is not consistency among the kindergartens.

Discuss 57

Discuss budgeting of hospitality events, how many events can we pull off and to what extent can we 'host' them. Lisa needs a budget in order to plan, she has been budget shopping and cooking for each event. It would be hard to scale back the amount of food, and many serving items did not make the move and Lisa has had to replace them through thrift store shopping. The cost of doing the events has been scaled down as far as it can go. There is a list of reoccurring annual events, such as opening ceremony, Grandparents day, closing ceremonies, spring concert, and teacher appreciation day. Additional events just need two weeks notice, such as community and architects meeting and workshops. Lisa on average has never spent more than \$150/event. The plan is to budget 2011 events based on the year before. Perhaps a spreadsheet of events and

costs would be a useful guide. Melisa has created a hospitality event request form in order for Lisa to be able to plan for each event. There may be more hospitality events this year because of more activity in the new location.

Action Items

- Make spreadsheet of anticipated hospitality events and budget costs
- o Encourage use of form
- o Check with 4th grade coffee re interest in hosting new parent meetings
- o Get Lisa assistance when events come in clumps

Follow-up: 2011-12 PC Budget Mark Discuss 10 We have a \$6,500 surplus going into this year and with the current proposed budget we anticipate to run over by the end of the year. How should we operate? The expenses we project exceed our income, our strategy is to bring additional income. We expect to run \$500-600 in the red this year. But that could change if the cost of sports programs increases from last year etc. The plan is to operate within the budget so that we do no deplete our reserve, we want a balanced budget.

Action Items

- Mark is going to go back and build in more income to the budget
- Fundraiser chairs (Laura, Jen and Melissa) will try and follow through with action items listed above, to generate additional income to PC
 - o check about an annual give back request at Briar Patch (for parents that forget to do it at the cash register), perhaps even an end of year rebate request
 - o refresh amazon.com link that gives back to the school, a yuba river store front, remind the parents of this system especially before the holidays
- Mark will bring the budget back next meeting to vote on it

Playground Development Jen/Makio Discuss 6
Jen and Makio reported that the Playground Committee met on October 3rd, where things will go and potential changes were discussed, but the lower grades were not discussed. The next meeting will have a scaled map of school playground space. The space between the stairs is an area where things could be added, like a dirt box, sand box, more natural forms. It is really just this small area that is still being discussed. No new large structures in the main playground will be built because of fire truck access needs. Break down structures with shade are being designed for the area along the fences where the EZups were placed during the Harvest Fest. The Playground committee will announce the next meeting, Monday October 24th in the next newsletter and the lower grades playground will be included in this next meeting. Perhaps parent council funds can be used to implement this new playground vision.

Sports Programs Veronica Discuss 8 (4:30pm)

Sports programs need parent council funds to continue, especially Volley Ball and Basketball. Recreation League is typically more than a school team. Our auditorium is not available for sports teams to use so we have to rent space elsewhere. Currently teams go to Ready Springs for games, and this may be needed for practice. We would have to retrofit our auditorium/multipurpose room in order to use it. PC funds may be needed for this. Even when kids all pay a fee to participate in a sports team the sports program typically loses money because of tournament fees and rental space. Girls BBall is currently not practicing anywhere because they have nowhere to practice, they just play the games. An Auditorium committee could look into how the auditorium could be retrofitted, then Caleb could take a proposal to the landlord to get permission to use it. Protecting the lights is a key issue. And can Parent Council funds be used to make the needed changes. Is Parent Council going to pay for uniforms and balls, last year we spend \$415, this year we budgeted \$500 for this expense but there may be additional expenses, like for football, boys volley ball etc. Volley Ball and Basketball typically ask for PC funds, many coaches just pay out of pocket. Could we create a Sports program budget for all the school sports so that PC funds are spent more equitability? First step would be to solicit input from all the coaches on past expenses. Until then, Mark will increase this expense item in the annual budget to reflect anticipated increases.

Follow-up: Treasurer Stipend Mark Discuss/Vote 3 Mark wanted to clarify the Treasurer Stipend from last meeting. The PC treasurer position is structured to include support of PC operating funds, as well as support of class funds. A \$500 annual stipend will be attached to the class fund support portion of the role, due to the complexity, time commitment, and need to support 10+ class funds. If the PC treasurer elects to not take on the class fund support portion of the duties, then the \$500 stipend can be used to retain someone else to perform those duties – but that would only be if the treasurer refuses that portion of the duties. The PC voted to augment last meetings' approval with another approval of the above.
